A great everyday white! Pale gold in color, its nose (smell) is fairly simple with the sweet, subtle presence of cantaloupe and pear. Upon first taste however, several more flavors pop up including hints of citrus, honey and grass, like a dry summer's lawn. This is a very refreshing dry wine with solid acidity that makes your mouth water and a crisp clean finish. There's none of that tart grapefruit that you get from many other Sauvignon Blancs, which makes for some very easy drinking...easy like Sunday morning. So easy in fact that we recommend polishing off the bottle in one sitting because this one is not meant to sit around. Serve fairly cold.
