Wine: 2006 Snipes Canyon Ranch Viognier

Comments: Viognier (pronounced vee-own-yay), a white grape variety heretofore relatively unknown outside its native region of the northern Rhône Valley in France, is being embraced in the new world as a terrific alternative to Chardonnay. It has full body and mouth-feel, along with its intense flavors of tropical fruit, mangoes, pears, and peaches. Serve this wine chilled, but not cold, for best flavors.
